## PROJECT UPDATE

CPM was appointed by Port of Brisbane Pty Ltd (PBPL) to assist in the development of a new \$177 million mega cruise facility for Brisbane and South-East Queensland near the mouth of the Brisbane River at Luggage Point.

The proposed facility will be able to cater to cruise vessels of all sizes and will also enable mega ships (vessels longer than 270m) to utilise Brisbane as a base port, transforming the city and the wider region into a major cruise destination. The new facility will help grow the number or international and domestic cruise visitors to Brisbane, significantly boosting the local and state economies and providing the cruise industry with a dedicated facility.

#### **Current Progress**

The 208m wharf and marine work including 4 x 4.3m dia mooring dolphin piles has reached practical completion.

The Civil works are well progressed with substantial areas complete including access roads and carparks 1,2 & 3 with finishing works and landscaping currently underway.

The Terminal building is also well advanced with all structural and main fit out works complete and the elevated walkway installed. Final fit out is well underway.



The Passenger Boarding Bridges, a vital link between the building and the vessel, have left Spain on their journey to Brisbane and are expected to arrive in July 2020.
